



Ateangaireacht Chomhdhála (MA/Diplóma Iarchéime)

Tá an clár seo bunaithe ar an gCéim Mháistreachta Eorpach in Ateangaireacht Chomhdhála – clár a forbraíodh i gcomhar le hinstitiúidí an Aontais Eorpaigh. Is é seo an t-aon chlár dá leithéid atá ar fáil in Éirinn. Cuireann ateangairí gairmiúla oiliúint ar mhic léinn sa dá chineál ateangaireachta (leantach agus comhuaineach) chun go mbeidh ar a gcumas na deiseanna leathana fostaíochta atá ar fáil d'ateangairí comhdhála a thapú. Is iad an Ghaeilge, an Béarla, an Fhraincis, an Spáinnis, an Iodáilis agus an Ghearmáinis atá á dtairiscint mar theangacha an chláir seo. D'fhéadfaí teangacha eile a chur ar fáil freisin ach dóthain éilimh a bheith orthu.



Deiseanna fostaíochta

Is gá cáilíocht aitheanta iarchéime a bhaint amach chun feidhmiú mar ateangaire gairmiúil. Is é an cúrsa seo an t-aon chúrsa in Éirinn inar féidir cáilíocht mar sin a bhaint amach. Cáilítear agus ullmhaítear mic léinn do scrúduithe iontrála na n-institiúidí idirnáisiúnta agus an AE agus tá céimithe an chúrsa fostaíthe ag na hinstitiúidí sin.

Tá poist ar fáil do chéimithe le rialtais náisiúnta agus le heagraíochtaí idirnáisiúnta, mar shampla, na Náisiúin Aontaithe, Eagraíocht Chonradh an Atlantaigh Thuaidh, an Eagraíocht Idirnáisiúnta Saothair agus an Eagraíocht Dhomhanda Sláinte. Ina theannta sin, éilítear seirbhísí ateangaireachta níos minice anois ag comhdhálacha, tionóil agus féilte in Éirinn.

Próifíl Chéimí



Céim an-mhór i dtreo na gairme ag leibhéal an AE is ea an MA san Ateangaireacht Chomhdhála i nGaillimh. Díreítear ar scileanna praiticiúla le cinntiú go mbaimeann na mic léinn na cáilíochtaí cuí amach le tabhairt faoin ateangaireacht go proifisiúnta. Foghlaimítear faoi na modhanna éagsúla ateangaireachta agus faoi fheidhmiú an AE, rud a chabhráíonn go mór má tá súil agat tabhairt faoi obair ag an leibhéal sin. Conference Interpreting (MA/Postgraduate Diploma)

This programme is based on the European Masters in Conference Interpreting – a programme developed in conjunction with the institutions of the European Union and it is the only course of its kind in Ireland. Training is provided by practicing professionals in both modes of conference interpreting. This qualification enables students to avail of the wide range of employment opportunities available to professional, qualified, conference interpreters. Throughout the course, students will study the institutions of the European Union and the University organises a study visit to the European Parliament and Commission, getting an insight into a conference interpreter's working life. Irish, English, French, Spanish, Italian, and German have been offered on the programme to date, with provision for other languages, where possible, based on student demand.



Career Opportunities

This programme equips students with the requisite professional skills in conference interpreting, as well as providing specific knowledge of the interpreting profession, enabling them to avail of the considerable employment opportunities available in this sector. Interpreters must have a postgraduate qualification in Conference Interpreting to allow them to work as a professional conference interpreter. This is the only programme in Ireland that provides this professional qualification. Employment opportunities are available with national governments and many international organizations, for example, the UN, NATO, ILO and WHO. In Ireland, interpreters are increasingly in demand at a growing number of conferences, meetings and festivals across the country.

Course Level: 9

Duration: One year (full-time)

Entry Requirements: A 2.2 Honours Degree at level 8, or a 2.2 postgraduate award in a related discipline. In addition, candidates will be expected to have: Sound general knowledge, good communication skills and a high degree of motivation. Admission to the programme is subject to success in both a suitability test and an interview.

Graduate Profile



At first, I decided to do my MA in Conference Interpreting at NUIG because it is recognised and recommended by the European Institutions but also because it follows the EMCi curriculum and. Being trained by professional interpreters using professional-level equipment and the possibility to be surrounded by other curious-minded students seemed very appealing. However, I was also looking for a Masters with a positive atmosphere that would allow me to progress naturally. That is exactly what happened! I found trainers that encouraged collaboration between fellow students, not competition. Lecturers were always very supportive, keen to share their experience with us and to teach us all the other skills we needed such as how to manage stress and anxiety when interpreting. Lastly, our Masters is the only Conference Interpreting programme that offers Irish. Professional interpreting is a small and highly competitive market. This Masters gave me the confidence I needed to enter it and a group of fellow interpreters I know I can work with and rely upon.
