Tá meascán tomhaiste ann den staidéar acadúil agus den oiliúint phraiticiúil san iriseoireacht, sa léiriú físe agus raidió, sa chraoltóireacht agus sna hilmheáin, chomh maith le staidéar ar theanga agus ar litríocht na Gaeilge. Tá an chéim á tairiscint ag an Acadamh i gcomhpháirt le Roinn na Gaeilge, Ollscoil na Gaillimhe.

Seimeastar Gaeltachta & Socrúchán Oibre

Bíonn an chéad seimeastar den tríú bliain ar siúl in Ionad na hOllscoile ar an gCeathrú Rua i gcoilár Ghaeltacht Chonamara. Bíonn deis agat ansin barr feabhais a chur ar labhairt na teanga, agus tuiscint a fháil ar oidhreacht agus ar dhúchas na Gaeltachta. Sa dara seimeastar beidh deis agat taithí oibre a dhéanamh in earnáil na meán, nó tionscadal 'foghlaim sa phobal' a chur i gcrích. Má roghnaíonn tú an taithí oibre, gheobhaidh tú cúnamh agus tacaíocht a chuirfidh ar do chumas taithí fhíorluachmhar a fháil sna meáin le TG4, RTÉ, Raidió na Gaeltachta nó san earnáil neamhspleách raidió agus teilifíse. Gheobhaidh tú tuiscint ar leith ar shaol na meán comhaimseartha san intéirneacht sin, déanfaidh tú teagmhálacha luachmhara, agus gheobhaidh tú scileanna praiticiúla ar an láthair oibre a sheasfaidh leat agus tú sa tóir ar phost amach anseo.

Beidh tú inniúil ar struchtúr an scéil agus ar theanga na físe; beidh tú in ann anailís a dhéanamh ar ról na meán sa tsochaí chomhaimseartha; agus beidh tuiscint ghrinn agat ar shaol agus ar chultúr na teanga mar theanga bheo sa lá atá inniu ann. The BA (Cumarsáid & Gaeilge) is a dynamic four-year degree in media and Irish which is taught entirely through Irish. It has been extensively updated to provide a balanced mix of academic study and practical, hands-on learning in journalism, television and radio production, broadcasting and multimedia, as well as Irish language and literature. This degree programme is offered by the Acadamh in conjunction with the Department of Irish at University of Galway.

Gaeltacht Semester & Work Placement

During the first semester of third year you will be based at the University's Gaeltacht campus in An Cheathrú Rua at the heart of the Connemara Gaeltacht. Here you will have the opportunity to achieve a high standard of spoken Irish, and deepen your understanding of Gaeltacht heritage and dúchas. During the second semester you will work as an intern in a media or public relations organisation, or complete a community-based learning project. If you choose the internship, you will be given help and support to gain invaluable industry experience in high-quality internships in TG4, RTÉ, Raidió na Gaeltachta and the independent television and radio sector. These sought-after opportunities will give you a unique insight into the contemporary media world during which you will make invaluable contacts and gain practical, on-the-ground skills that will help you in your future search for employment.

This degree is aimed specifically at jobs in the field of language skills. Excellent opportunities now exist in Ireland and Europe for those with a translation / language qualification – indeed, there is a shortage of qualified translators to fill job vacancies. This highly practical degree course focuses on the linguistic, technological and workplace skills needed to become a professional translator.

For the BA (Gaeilge & Léann an Aistriúcháin) Irish, Léann an Aistriúcháin and one other subject are chosen in first year. Irish and Léann an Aistriúcháin are taken from second year onwards.

Work Placement

If Léann an Aistriúcháin and Irish are selected for the degree, a one-year work placement (September to April) is available with an organization or business operating through Irish. In recent years, these have included the Translation Service of the Houses of the Oireachtas, An Taibhdhearc (National Irish language Theatre), Gaillimh le Gaeilge, the European Commission (Brussels), and community organizations in the Gaeltacht.

Career Opportunities

Our graduates are successful in finding jobs in various areas where language skills are important. We have strong links with the EU institutions and many of our graduates are now working in those organizations as well as in the Irish state sector. Other graduates are now utilizing the skills acquired on this degree in jobs in communication and education.

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The Gaeltacht Semester

The University of Galway offers a unique learning experience to students who undertake Irish as part of their studies on the undergraduate programme. As with other degree programmes that include languages, students who study Irish are offered an opportunity to benefit from an immersion study period of 12 weeks in either the Connemara or Donegal Gaeltacht areas during year 3 of their studies. The university is in the favourable position of having 3 university campuses in some of the strongest Gaeltacht regions in the country, namely: An Cheathrú Rua and Carna in Galway and Gaoth Dobhair in Donegal. At the end of the Gaeltacht semester, the students are more competent in Irish and, as a result, more confident in using it when undertaking work placements in semester two.

Students indicate their campus of choice and accommodation with local families is arranged for the semester. The Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media generously supplement the cost of the accommodation, with student contributing only €470 (2024 fee) for the entire 12 week period. Accommodation includes all meals; breakfast, lunch and dinner.

This is a four-year degree programme in Commerce including the study of the Irish Language, allowing students to develop their language skills while gaining valuable insights into business and culture. It is the ideal qualification for students who want to build a career in business or who simply wish to expand their career choices.

The greatest advantage that students studying this course have is that in year three the programme is divided between a one semester internship in an Irish-speaking environment and a semester studying at University of Galway's Gaeltacht campus in an Cheathrú Rua.

This programme meets all of the Irish language requirements set by the Teaching Council.

Gaeltacht Semester

Students will spend a full semester studying in Áras Mháirtín Uí Chadhain, a University of Galway centre in an Cheathrú Rua. They will study six modules in this Gaeltacht environment. 'Inniúlachtaí Gairme' or Professional Competencies is a module that will prepare the students to confidently undertake a period of work experience after the Gaeltacht semester.

I decided to do the BComm with Irish because of my family business background and my interest in accounting, which developed through my secondary school studies. However, I always loved the Irish language at school and was keen to keep it up at third level. And that was why the BComm le Gaeilge stood out to me. The Irish Language Stream allows students to develop their Irish language skills throughout their four year full law degree. The stream is available for students undertaking the following law degrees:

- Law (BCL) GY251
- Law and Business GY250
- Law (BCL) and Human Rights GY252
- Law and Taxation GY253
- Law (BCL), Criminology and Criminal Justice GY254

- One semester at University of Galway's Gaeltacht campus and one semester of professional work placement in an Irish-speaking legal environment.

The Irish Language Stream covers Legal Irish modules which give students the opportunity to develop their Irish oral and Irish written skills, and enhance their Irish legal terminology. Students will be empowered to communicate ideas and opinions through oral and written Irish.

Career Opportunities

It is the ideal qualification for students who want to build a career in law and open up a range of exciting job opportunities working through the Irish language. The qualification opens up opportunities for employment in legal departments of an Irish language organisation, law firms which provide legal advice through the Irish language, the public sector, legal translation and interpretation, and in the media. There are also great job opportunities for Irish Lawyer Linguists in the Institutions of the European Union. EU Lawyer Linguists ensure that all new legislation has the same meaning in each official language of the European Union.



Year 3: Professional Work Placement and Gaeltacht

A great advantage that students studying this course have is that in year three the programme is divided between one semester studying at University of Galway's Gaeltacht campus in an Cheathrú Rua and one semester of professional work placement in an Irish-speaking legal environment.

Entry Requirements

Students who wish to undertake the Irish Language Stream must have at least a H4 grade or higher in Leaving Cert Irish.

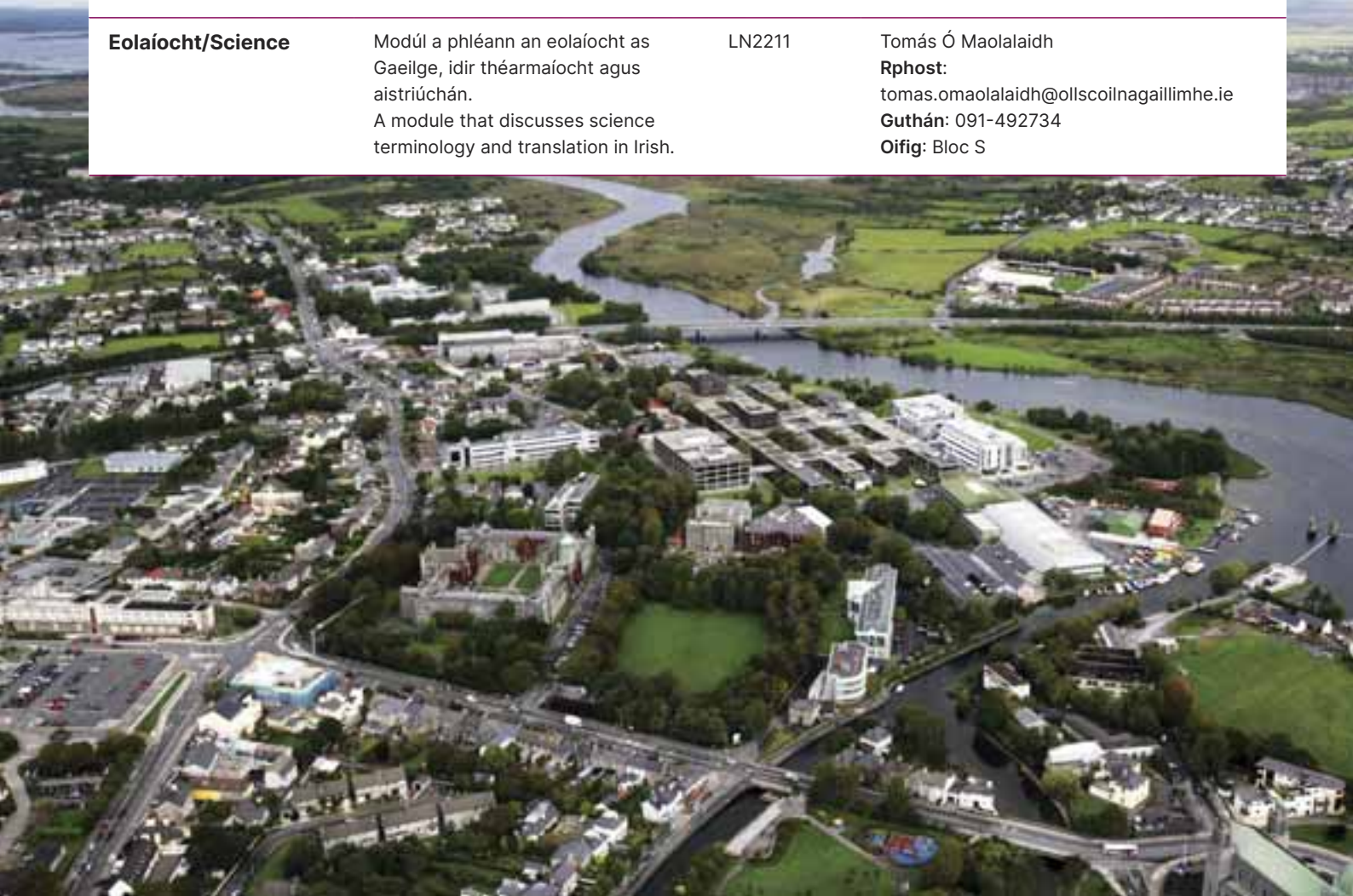

IRISH LANGUAGE COURSES FOR STUDENTS

As part of the University's aim of promoting the Irish language, Acadamh na hOllscolaíochta Gaeilge provides the following programmes for undergraduate and postgraduate students who wish to learn Irish or to improve their ability in the language while at university:

An Diplóma sa Ghaeilge (Levels A2, B1, B2 & C1)

GRADUATE INSIGHTS



Ní raibh mé cinnte an é treo na cumarsáide a bhí uaim agus mé ag triail ar Ollscoil ach bhí mé cinnte gur theastaigh uaim céim a bhaint amach trí mheán na Gaeilge. Is féidir liom a rá go cinnte agus mé ag caitheamh súil siar nach bhfuil aiféala ar bith orm maidir le mo rogha cúrsa. Ón gcéad lá riamh, cuireadh trealamh taifeadta inár láimhe agus as sin amach fuaireamar taithí taifeadta agus craolacháin i réimsí éagsúla den earnáil. Ní dóigh liom go dtugann cúrsa céime ar bith eile a leithéid de thaithí phraiticiúil do mhic léinn.

Ceaptar nach bhfuil ach dá rogha ann do na céimithe cumarsáide, sin Raidió na Gaeltachta agus TG4. Cé gur craoltóirí iontacha iad, níl iontu ach dhá rogha as liosta leathan fostóirí in earnáil na meán Gaeilge. Sin an fáth gurb é an BA (Cumarsáid & Gaeilge) an rogha is fearr d'éinne atá idir dhá chomhairle faoina gcúrsa. Le linn na céime, gheobhaidh sibh scileanna láithreoireachta, iriseoireachta, eagarthóireachta, chomh maith le tuiscint leathan ar na meáin shóisialta, dlí agus eiticí agus an tionchar atá ag na meáin chumarsáide ar ár saolta. Bhí áit lárnach ag 'machnamh criticiúil' inár gcúrsa, ábhar atá thar a bheith luachmhar dar liom, cibé cén t-ábhar atá i mbun agaibh.

Caithfidh sibh seimeastar in Acadamh na hOllscoile sa Cheathrú Rua, áit ina gcuirfidh sibh bhur scileanna praiticiúla i gcleachtadh. Ina dhiaidh sin rachaidh sibh ar thaithí oibre ach chun an fhírinne a rá, tosaíonn an taithí oibre sa chéad bhliain nuair a bhíonn ar na mic léinn 'voxpops' (míreanna gearra fuaime) a thaifeadadh timpeall an champais. I wasn't sure if communication was the direction that I wanted when I was heading to University, but I was sure that I wanted to undertake a degree through Irish. I can definitely say looking back that I have no regrets about my choice of course. From day one, recording equipment was put in our hands and from then on we gained recording and broadcasting experience in various areas of the sector. I don't think any other degree course offers its students such practical experience.

It is thought that there are only two employment choices for communication graduates, that of Raidió na Gaeltachta and TG4. Although they are great broadcasters, they are only two choices from a wide list of employers in the Irish media sector. That's why the BA (Communications & Irish) is the best choice for anyone who is in two minds about their course. During the degree, you will gain presentation skills, journalism, editing, as well as a broad understanding of social media, law and ethics and the impact of the media on our lives. 'Critical thinking' played a central role in our course, a subject which I think is extremely valuable, whatever subject you are studying.

You will spend a semester at the University campus in Cheathrú Rua, where you will put your practical skills into practice. After that you will go on work experience but to tell the truth, the work experience starts in the first year when the students have to record 'voxpops' (short audio segments) around the campus. You will learn filmmaking, scriptwriting and production skills from lecturers with years of experience working in the sector. I often saw one of my lecturers on TG4! The Irish media is changing and developing day by day and the nicest thing about the communication course is that it does not focus on one specific aspect of the media, it covers a wide-range of subject areas. This course gave me the confidence to broadcast my own radio show on FlirtFM. After that, I presented some programs for Raidió Rí-Rá and a local station in my area. The possibilities for future communication graduates is a list to be reckoned with.
